

Charter Flight 095-1

Fly the cargo, 16 prize world class jumpin' frogs, one being "Ribett Ribett," this year's top contender, into Calavares County for spring training in preparation for the annual Frog Jumpin' contest. The customer requests that we not exceed a 500 fpm climb or descent rate as a recent federally-funded study has indicated that the rapid change in pressure might cause severe depression in jumpin' frogs resulting in short, tiny hops instead of long, soaring leaps.

FS-98: KTVL Airport = TVL Airport

NOTE: Close and secure all hatches and vents in the cargo area before departure.

DO NOT EXCEED 500 FPM CLIMB OR DESCENT!
