You will head north ow, over the largest East/West mountain range in North America and then over the massive North Slope Region to the Arctic Ocean.

Wiley Post-Will Rogers Memorial airport is name for the humorist Will Rogers and aviation pioneer Wiley Post who died in a plane crash here in 1935.							

Leaving Barrow, you have a choice of the short route, (AK_011-A) 291 miles, or the shore side long route, (AK-011-B)

Head down the coast past Mt. Fairweather. 15,300 ft high and only 15 miles to the ocean. Then turn into Cross Sound and Lynn Canal up to the Gold Rush Town of Skagway.
