

# **St. Barthelemy's Challenge**

## **Flight Video Recordings**

**001-06-15 Landing**

**001-06-16 Take-off**

We have included two video recordings of St. Barthelemy in this package: Landing at Rwy 10, and Take-off from Rwy 10. Viewing these videos will enhance your own pleasure of flying the two routes. Besides seeing the plane in motion, you will also have a wonderful view of the add-on scenery. Many thanks to Bob Reid for doing the videos for us.

The videos are very brief, so watch each from the various Flight-Sim views; Tower, Spot Plane, etc.

To Watch the videos, paste the two video files:

**St Barths Rwy 10 Landing.vid**

**and**

**St Barths Rwy 10 Take-off.vid**

into the FS2000 PILOTS folder. Open Flight Sim, and load up your DC-3. You must make certain settings before you start the videos, because once the videos are running nothing can be changed.

**For take-off,**

**Set the wind to 15 kts from 100°.**

**Lower one-notch of flaps.**

**Close the aircraft door.**

**Select the desired view of the aircraft.**

Be aware that the video recording does not have the capability to show the gear being raised or lowered, and not all panel instruments will indicate properly, for example, the VSI gauge.

To show Take-off video, go to Options/Video then select “St Barths Rwy 10 Take-off” from the menu. Click Play, and enjoy the flight. Repeat this for all of the FlightSim views.

Ignore the “Recording Interval” box for play back.

**For Landing,**

**Set the wind to 15 kts from 100°, if it's not already set.**

**Lower two notches of flaps.**

**Close the aircraft door.**

**Select the desired view of the aircraft.**

**Play as before.**

**WANT TO RECORD AND SUBMIT YOUR OWN VIDEO? ... The Landing Only.**

Begin at 1500 ft altitude, Record at ONE SECOND Interval. Follow the flight directions on the previous page. Submit as XXX-TFFJ.vid, where XXX is your pilot number, as in PIREPS.
